Fashion

Fashion is distracting, intriguing(激起兴趣的) and demanding. We admire it, buy it, store it, wear it, and finally discard it. We identify ourselves with it and judge others by it. Fashion reflects our economy and technology and politics, as well as our pastimes, professions and taste. As such, fashion is a sensitive barometer of popular culture. We define fashion as the clothing styles that are most popular at a particular period of time and place with a group of people, large or small. The elements of fashion that are of most interest for popular

culture studies are its changing character and meanings. The most remarkable aspect of fashion in recent years has been the acceleration of change. Its significance lies in its reflection of culture and society.

The term "fashion" is derived from the Latin *factio*. It refers to the make or shape of a thing or the current style or mode of apparent. Fashion has the concept of "style". In relation to apparel, a style refers to a garment with particular features or characteristics that distinguish it from other garments of the same type. A style may or may not be popular at any given time, and its distinctive features do not change. For example, bell-bottomed jeans may or may not be popular at a given time, but the shape of the flared legs distinguishes the bell-bottomed style from pegged or tapered jeans. The style or styles that are accepted or popular at a particular time in a particular place are called "fashions".

Styles of dress that become the mode are products of the apparel industry, which with the rise of a consumer culture grew by leaps and bounds after the mid-1990s. Before the 1960s, the fashion industry could dictate what people wore. Since then, however, Americans have shown an increasing interest in expressing their individuality. The second half of the twentieth century also saw the rise of men's fashion and an interest flourished in dressing correctly on the job, at first in suits and toward the end of the century in casual word dress. Advice books on how to dress continue to sell well. An interest in examining everyday life, issues of gender, and material culture also increased the attention given to fashion. The vintage clothing market likewise broadened the field of fashion for creative dressing and for collectors. The media aided fashion with the transformation of designers into celebrities. Indeed, the study of fashion has itself become fashionable.
